**ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2018-003**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CARENCRO CITY  
COUNCIL AMENDING THE CARENCRO  
CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE  
CONDUCT OF PARADES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Carencro City Council that:

**SECTION 1:**

The Carencro City Council (“Council”) now finds it necessary and expedient to amend the Carencro Code of Ordinances (Code) in order to enhance the safety and the enjoyment of the citizens of the City of Carencro (City) while attending and/or participating in any of the parades conducted in the City by prohibiting the use and/or presence of alcoholic beverages on any float or other conveyance involved in such parades.

**SECTION 2:**

In consideration of Section 1 above, the Council hereby amends Chapter 74, “Traffic and Vehicles”, Article V, “Parades”, Section 74-112, “Rules and regulations for parades” of the Carencro Code of Ordinances, by revising the wording of subparagraph (2) of Section 74-112, such that said subparagraph shall hereafter read as follows:

“(2) The following items are not to be thrown, handed or in any way delivered from any vehicle or float, or sold from any cart, to-wit: drug-related items, including, but not limited to, items depicting drugs or drug use, sexually oriented items, glass containers, alcoholic beverages and any item that contains any portion of alcohol or any pointed object. No music of a vulgar or sexual nature may be played on any float or vehicles.”

With the exception of verbiage regarding alcoholic beverages added to subparagraph (2) as designated herein above, Section 74-112 shall otherwise remain unchanged.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE:**

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon return of the ordinance to the City Clerk (after execution by the Mayor), on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after receipt of the ordinance by the Mayor without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

**SECTION 4: REPEALER:**

Any City of Carencro ordinance or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-004**

An ordinance of the Carencro City Council amending Ordinance No. 2017-001, by deleting Section 6 in its entirety providing that dealers shall not be allowed to take compensation in accounting for and remitting the tax levied by ordinance 2017-001.

**Be it ordained** by the Carencro City Council:

**Whereas**, Ordinance 2017-001, adopted on February 20, 2017 levied a sales tax and provided for the collection thereof and other matters in connection therewith, and;

**Whereas**, Section 6 of Ordinance 2017-001 grants dealers compensation for timely payment of collected taxes, and;

**Whereas**, the City of Carencro desires to make amendments to the 2016 Sales Tax ordinance to provide that dealers shall not be allowed to take compensation in accounting for and remitting the tax levied by said ordinance

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:**

**Section 1:** That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2017-001 is hereby deleted in its entirety.

**Section 2:** Dealers shall not be allowed to take compensation (vendor's compensation) in accounting for and remitting the tax authorized by the 2016 sales tax ordinance.

**Section 3:** The remainder of the provisions of the 2016 sales tax ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4:** All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 5:** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon return of the ordinance to the City Clerk, after execution by the Mayor, at midnight on the tenth day after receiving the ordinance without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
