Mayor Glenn L. Brasseaux called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Councilman Antoine Babineaux led the Pledge of Allegiance in English which was followed by a moment of silent prayer. Mr. Easton Bourgeois, an attendee led the Pledge of Allegiance in French.

Announcements made by Mayor Brasseaux included the following:

\*Mayor Brasseaux recognized Mrs. Juanita Prejean, co-owner of Big Poppa's Gym who won the title of "Mrs. Black Louisiana US 2010" in October 2009, then represented Louisiana and won the title of "Mrs. US United" in Atlanta, Georgia this month. The Mayor and Council congratulated Mrs. Prejean for winning the title and thank her for representing and promoting Carencro in a positive way.

Councilwoman Kim Guidry made a motion to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting of the Carencro City Council on June 21, 2010; seconded by Councilman Antoine Babineaux; motion was approved.

The Mayor then asked for any questions or comments concerning the departments' monthly reports and there were none.

INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCE:

Ordinance No. 2010-009: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council repealing Ordinance No. 2010-003 concerning amendments to Chapter 10, Article III horses, mules or animal drawn vehicles, and other matters relating thereto.

Councilman L. J. Boudreaux made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 2010-009; seconded by Councilman Antoine Babineaux; motion was approved.

Ordinance No. 2010-010: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council authorizing the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Lafayette Consolidated Government (LCG) to rehabilitate (reconstruct) Sonnier Road within the corporate limits of Carencro.

Councilwoman Kim Guidry made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 2010-010; seconded by Councilman J. L. Richard; motion was approved.

PUBLIC HEARING:

FINAL ADOPTION:

Mayor Brasseaux declared a public hearing for consideration of adopting the following ordinances:

Ordinance No. 2010-005: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council adopting an adjusted millage rate of 3.96 mills to be levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within the City of Carencro, Parish of Lafayette for the year 2010 for the purpose of raising revenue.

Mayor Brasseaux called for questions from the Council and the audience. There being none it was moved by Councilman Antoine Babineaux to final adopt Ordinance No. 2010-005; seconded by Councilman Allen Conque; motion was approved.

Ordinance No. 2010-006: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council increasing the millage rate, but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rate on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2010, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied.

Mayor Brasseaux called for questions from the Council and the audience. There being none it was moved by Councilman J.L. Richard to final adopt Ordinance No. 2010-006; seconded by Councilman Antoine Babineaux; motion was approved.

Ordinance No. 2010-007: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council amending the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 78, Article 1, General, adding a new Section 78-4 (a) and (b) prohibiting the use of any equipment or device on the premises of any customer which would result in the theft of city utilities.

Mayor Brasseaux called for questions from the Council and audience. City Manager Lloyd Rochon asked that the council include an amendment to add to Section 78-4 (a) "including, but not limited to charges for replacement of damaged equipment."

Councilman L.J. Boudreaux made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2010-007 including the amendment recommended by City Manager Lloyd Rochon; seconded by Councilwoman Kim Guidry; motion was approved.

Ordinance No. 2010-008: An Ordinance of the Carencro City Council authorizing amendment of the contract between the Parks and Recreation Commission of Carencro,

Inc. (Commission) and the City of Carencro to eliminate the Commission's lease payment obligation.

Mayor Brasseaux called for questions from the Council and audience. There being none, it was moved by Councilman L.J. Boudreaux to final adopt Ordinance No. 2010-008; seconded by Councilwoman Kim Guidry; motion was approved.

#### RESOLUTION:

A Resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the 2009-2010 budget transferring \$13,899.00 from FEMA-Firefighters Grant City Match line item to Firefighters Equipment account for the purpose of five sets of turnout gear.

Motion was made by Councilman L.J. Boudreaux to approve this resolution; seconded by Councilwoman Kim Guidry; motion was approved.

#### PUBLIC HEARING:

Requested final plat approval of Tracts 3 & 4 of North Point (formerly Mouton Market Place) division of property, located in Section 26, 34, & 35, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, City of Carencro, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana by Derek Development Corporation, LLC. Bonnie Anderson presented the report of LCG's Planning, Zoning and Codes as well as her comments concerning compliance with the provisions of Carencro's ordinances. (Note: A copy of PZC comments as well as the comments concerning compliance with Carencro's requirements is on file in the Clerks Office)

Councilman J. L. Richard made a motion to request final plat approval based upon Bonnie Anderson's recommendations; seconded by Councilman L.J. Boudreaux; motion was approved.

Requested final plat approval for Carencro Village, "A Commercial Development" located in Sections 1 & 132, Township 8 South, and Township 9 South, Range 4 East, City of Carencro, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana by TEQ Land Company. Bonnie Anderson presented the report of LCG's Planning, zoning and Codes as well as her comments concerning compliance with the provisions of Carencro's ordinances. (Note: A copy of PZC comments as well as the comments concerning compliance with Carencro's requirements is on file in the Clerks Office)

Councilman J.L. Richard made a motion to request final plat approval based upon Bonnie Anderson's recommendations; seconded by Councilwoman Kim Guidry; motion was approved.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Mayor Brasseaux requested anyone wishing to speak announcing that they were a candidate for the upcoming city election could do so. Mr. William Meyer announced that he was a candidate for Chief of Police The following candidates running for city council included Mr. Tom Meyers, Mr. Timmy Duhon and Mr. Alfred Senegal. The city council

members Mr. J.L. Richard, Mr. Antoine Babineaux, Mr. L.J. Boudreaux and Ms. Kim Guidry also announce that they are running again for re-election on the city council.

Councilman Allen Conque thanked the citizens of Carencro for their vote of confidence in him throughout his 32 years of public service. He also wished the best to all the candidates running for office in Carencro.

Mayor Brasseaux then recognized the audience for questions and comments. With there being none, the meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
