EMERGENCY SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Glenn L. Brasseaux called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m. Council member Antoine Babineaux led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent prayer with prayers for our military service personnel and their families who have served our country and those who continue to serve defending our freedoms.

Mayor Brasseaux asked for a motion to amend the agenda to add Resolution 2017-035 regarding the Rue Basin Bridge.

Councilmember Babineaux made a motion to add Resolution 2017-035 to the agenda; seconded by Councilmember Richard; motion approved.

Mayor Brasseaux informed the council and the public that the Rue Basin Bridge was inspected by Professional Civil Engineer Colby Guidry with Huval & Associates, Inc. and found to have imminent structural failure. Due to the structural deficiencies of the Rue Basin Bridge and possibility of imminent structural failure, a public emergency has been declared for immediate correction to repair the bridge.

Resolution 2017-035: A resolution of the Carencro City Council recognizing and declaring the existence of a public emergency as a result of structural deficiencies found in the Rue Basin Bridge by Colby Guidry, Professional Civil Engineer.

Councilmember Sinegal made a motion to approve Resolution 2017-035; seconded by Councilmember Boudreaux; motion approved.

Councilmember Richard made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Councilmember Sinegal; motion approved.
