**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CARENCRO CITY
COUNCIL AMENDING THE CARENCRO
CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING
APPROVED DRAINAGE SYSTEMS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Carencro City Council that:

SECTION 1:

The Carencro City Council (“Council”) now finds it necessary and expedient to amend the Carencro Code of Ordinances (Code) in order to revise the specifications for drainage impact analysis; design standards applied to newly developed subdivisions within the City of Carencro. In order to enact those revisions at issue,

SECTION 2:

In consideration of Section 1 above, the Council hereby amends Chapter 30, “FLOODS”, Article VI, “Floods and Drainage Protection Standards”, Division 2, “Standards for All Protected Development”, Section 30 -106 (b) “Drainage design standards” of the Carencro Code of Ordinances, by deleting from said Section item number “(7)” in its entirety. **Said Section shall be further revised by renumbering all items of same which follow item “(7)” in order to maintain chronological numbering, such that item “(8)” shall be re-designated as item “(7)”;** item “(9)” shall be re-designated as item “(8)”; item “(10)” shall be re-designated as item “(9)”; item “(11)” shall be re-designated as item “(10)”; item “(12)” shall be re-designated as item “(11)”; and, item “(13)” shall be re-designated as item “(12)”.

In further consideration of Section 1 above, the Council hereby amends Chapter 30, ‘FLOODS’, Article VI, “Floods and Drainage Protection Standards”, Division **3, “Subdivisions”**, Section 30-122 - “Runoff determination methods”, by adding verbiage to said Section ~~paragraph~~ such that said Section ~~paragraph~~ shall hereafter read as follows:

“For drainage areas less than 200 acres, the design engineer shall use the rational method ($Q=ciA$) procedure for determining runoff rates, **with the exception of the rainfall intensity described in Section 30-124 (a).** For drainage areas between 200 and 2,000 acres, the design engineer shall use the most recent Soil Conservation Service (SCS) method, as modified by the state department of transportation and development procedure for determining runoff rates, **with the exception of rainfall depth described in Section 30-124(b).** For drainage areas greater than 2,000 acres, the design engineer shall use the most recent USGS regression procedure for determining runoff rates.

In further consideration of Section 1 above, the Council hereby amends Chapter 30, 'FLOODS', Article VI, "Floods and Drainage Protection Standards", Division 3, "Subdivision", Section 30-124-"Determination of rainfall intensity and duration" by deleting the word "duration" from the title of said Section and replacing same with the word "depth", such that the title of said Section shall hereafter read as follows: "Determination of rainfall intensity and depth". Said Section shall be further amended by deleting the wording of same in its entirety, and by rewriting said Section such that same shall hereafter read as follows:

(a)

Rainfall intensity. When utilizing the rational method, rainfall intensity shall be as published in the most recent version of National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Precipitation-Frequency Atlas of the United States. This information can be found at the NOAA National Weather Service Precipitation Frequency Data Server (PFDS) - <https://hdsc.nws.noaa.gov/hdsc/pfds/> by selecting "Data Type - Precipitation Intensity".

(b)

Rainfall depth. When utilizing the SCS Method, the rainfall depths shall be as published in the most recent version of National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Precipitation-Frequency Atlas of the United States. This information can be found at the NOAA National Weather Service Precipitation Frequency Data Server (PFDS) - <https://hdsc.nws.noaa.gov/hdsc/pfds/> and selecting "Data Type - Precipitation Depth".

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE:

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon return of the ordinance to the City Clerk (after execution by the Mayor), on the tenth (10th) day after receipt of the ordinance by the Mayor without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 4: REPEALER:

Any City of Carencro ordinance or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
